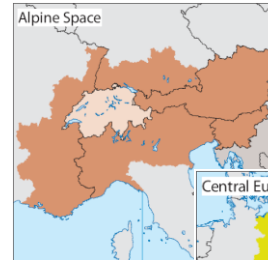

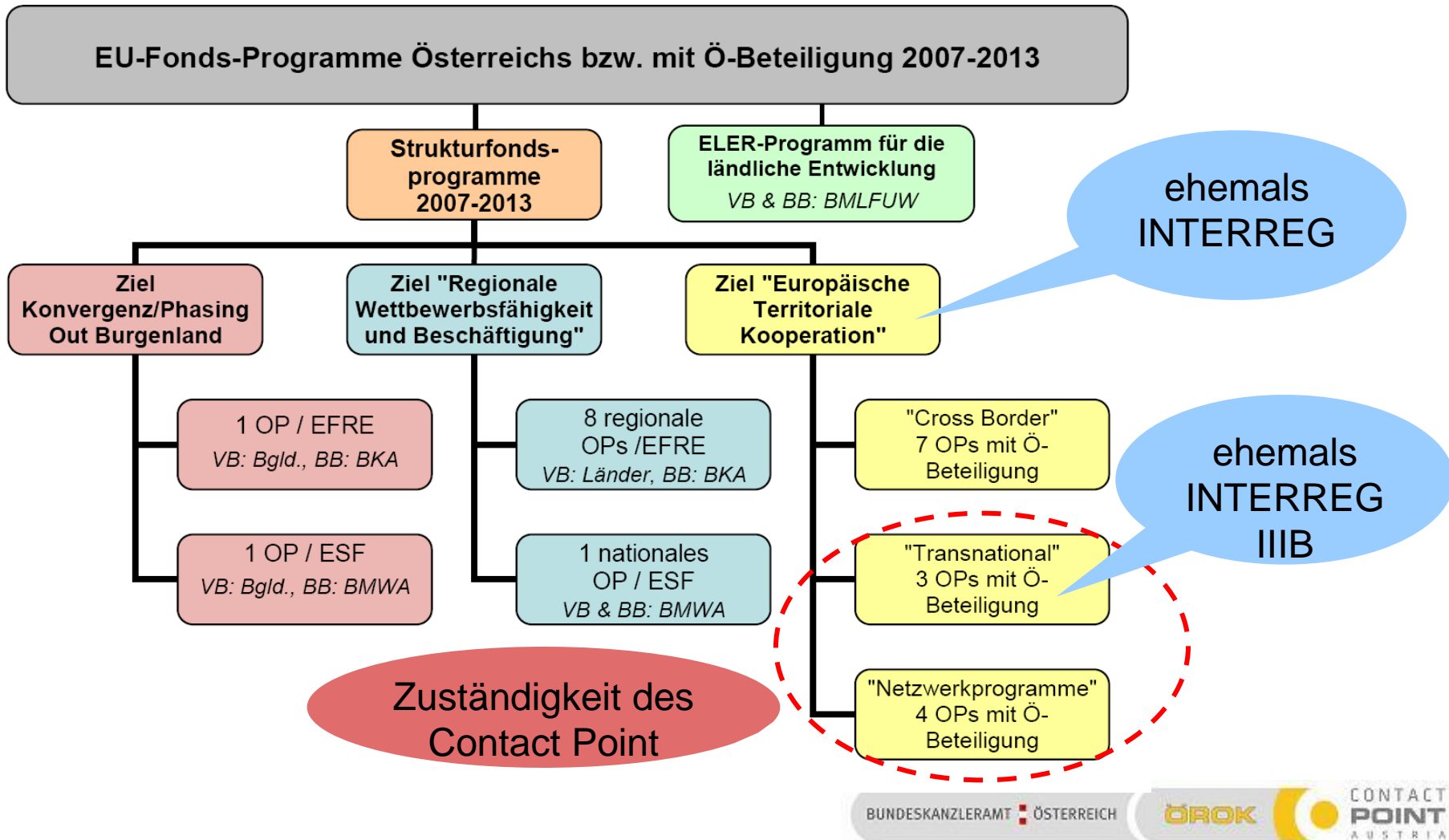

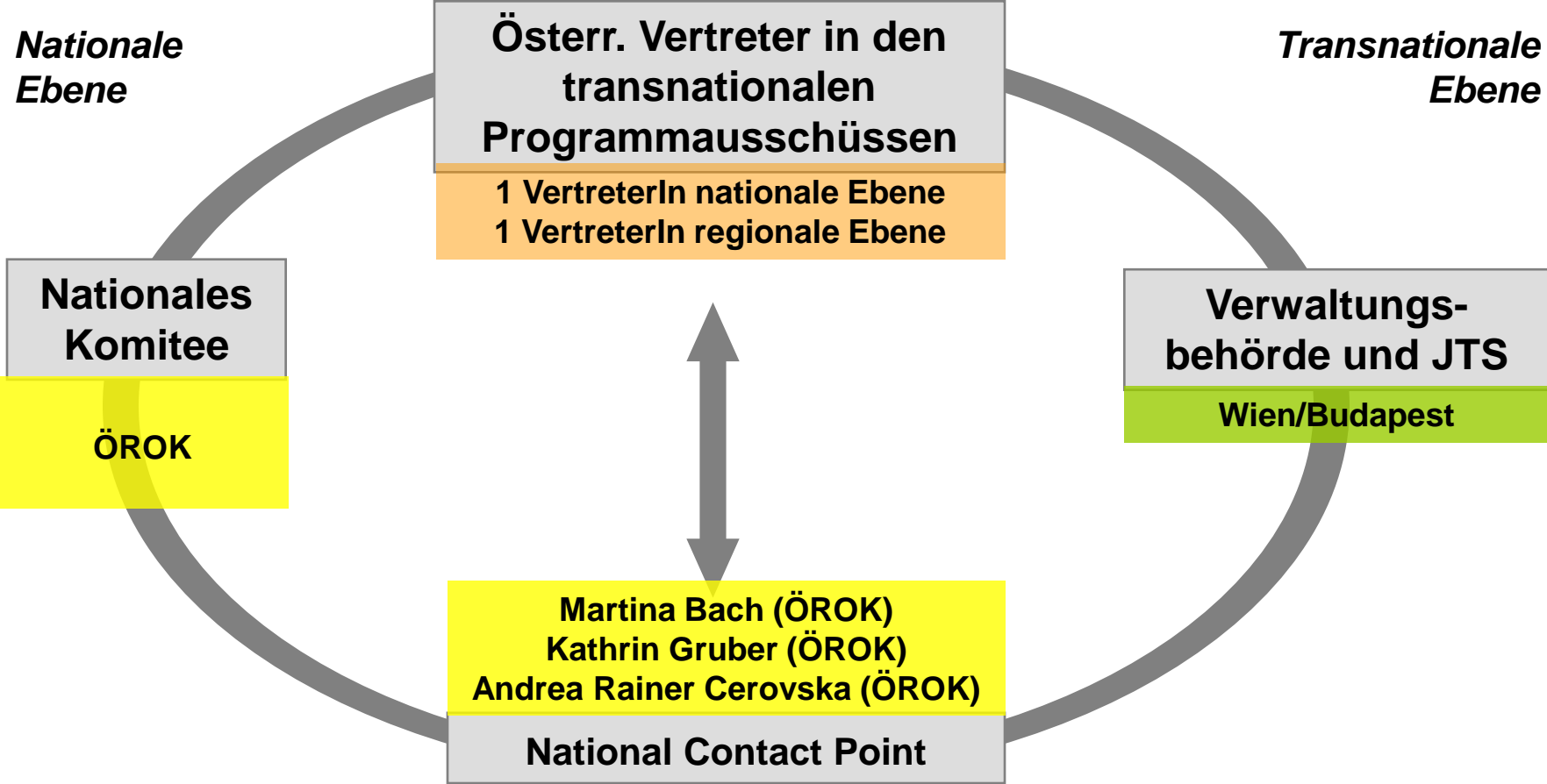


Territoriale Kooperationsprogramme 2007-13





Verankerung der Programmstrukturen in Österreich



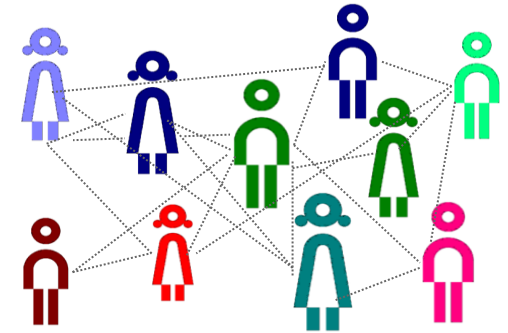

CENTRAL EUROPE – Ergebnisse der bisherigen Calls

- **3 Calls for Proposals (plus Restricted Call for Strategic Projects)** already launched and projects selected and approved for funding
- **94 projects approved along Calls 1-3**
 - 1st Call: 29 projects
 - 2nd Call: 37 projects
 - 3rd Call: 28 projects
- **Restricted Call for Strategic projects:** 7 projects approved - currently under negotiation
- **~ 83 % of the total ERDF Programme budget already allocated** (around 192 Mio € ERDF funds) in Calls 1-3 → amounting to ~92 % with the indicative allocation of the Restricted Call for Strategic projects

ET-struct - Activities

Summary of activities:

ET-struct will support stability and growth in regions fighting the effects of a global financial and economic crisis. What will the project do?

1. BRING TOGETHER three major players (policy/economy/education-training) that influence regions in lasting management structures. 2. COMPILER a dynamic inventory of skills / competences needed for Central Europe ("new-skills-for-new-jobs"). 3. DEVELOP / PILOT on-site and online learning systems to educate, train and retrain regional workforces.

Full details can be found on the ET-struct homepage www.etstruct.eu. What has been achieved so far? (A) Project Brochure in the six project languages and English. (B) An online draft Catalogue of Transnational Inventory Criteria (basis for the dynamic inventory of skills / competences). (C) Two online questionnaires in 6 project languages for regional surveys with stakeholders about jobs and skills. (D) Contact with and active participation of over 500 selected target groups.

In detail: Project Partner (PP) management structures and teams were established. The Partnership Agreement (PA), including project guidelines for coordination and reporting was prepared, negotiated and signed by the majority of PP before the end of the period. PP readily replied to the LP request for an Interim Financial and Interim Activity Report.

Earlier than planned, an Internal Start Up (renamed "Ad Hoc") Meeting was held in Vienna in February. As planned, the first 2-day Steering Committee (SC) Meeting also took place in Vienna in May.

WP2: Parallel to the above-mentioned activities, the ET-struct project brochure in seven languages was prepared, printed and disseminated, and the project homepage was developed and launched in May (to date 688 visits). Following the first SC Meeting, a transnational project Start up Event was held in Vienna with transnational and regional media communication (12x press releases; 10x press articles; 21x articles on other websites; 2x radio broadcasts; potentially 582.620 people reached). In June, the 1st electr. ET-struct Newsflash was sent to a specific transnational target group. The online Draft Catalogue of Transnational Inventory criteria (from WP1) was finalised. It and the related online questionnaire tools were posted on the project homepage. Regional policy/economy/education institutions were informed by the project partners
