The overall aim of the project is to compare regional policies and strategies (law in force) for the identification and management of forest based common lands, in order to assess their effectiveness in addressing a common conservation goal. At the centre of the debate there is a need to define tools for managing natural resources (such as forests and woods) which are economically viable for public authorities and appealing to the group of people responsible for the management of the natural area, but at the same time environmentally sustainable. In first instance the project will deal with the complex legal framework surrounding the common lands, while in a second phase there will be activities to demonstrate the validity of the approach under an environmental point of view. Once consolidated the structure and management system of common lands, the final part of the project wants to build a strategy to promote the common land management system on a higher political level.
