



Danube Transnational Programme

Job announcement

The ***Danube Transnational Cooperation programme*** is one of the successors of the South-East Europe Territorial Cooperation Programme 2007-2013. Joint transnational cooperation projects will be financed in the fourteen countries of the programme. In order to achieve its goals the programme is aiming at setting up a professional, effective ***Managing Authority and Joint Secretariat*** with educated and experienced international staff covering the thematic, managerial and financial competences related to programme management and implementation.

The programme implementation period is between 2014 and 2023.

Terms of employment

The positions are based on a five year full-time contract under Hungarian law. The contract will be concluded between the recruited candidates and the ***Ministry of National Economy***, hosting institution of the Danube MA and JS, and will be written in both Hungarian and English.

Salaries

The competitive salary will be set according to qualifications, experience and the costs associated with living abroad.

Location

The MA/JS is located, and the employment will be in ***Budapest, Hungary***.

Application and selection procedure

The deadline for applications is **1st June 2015**.

Interested applicants should submit the following documents:

- a ***CV in English***
- a ***motivation letter in English***

Applications must arrive no later than **13.00 CET 1st June 2015**.

These documents will constitute the basis for the initial stage of candidate selection. If successful at this stage, candidates will be asked to attend to an interview in Budapest which is planned for beginning of July 2015.
