




#### **Committed ERDF before call 4**



Before the approval of the new projects by the Programme Committee on 28 June 2012, 68 million € out of the 92 million € ERDF available for projects in the 2007-2013 co-funding period had been committed. The available funds for the call 4 for project proposals were: 9.8 million for Priority 1 "Competitiveness and Attractiveness", 6.5 million for Priority 2 "Accessibility and Connectivity" and 7.8 million for Priority 3 "Environment and Risk prevention".

### **Approved ERDF**



Out of the **24.1 millions of available funds** for this call for project proposals, 23.3 millions have been committed to 12 new projects: **9.2 millions on five Priority 1 projects**, **6.3 millions on three Priority 2 projects** and **7.8 millions on four Priority 3 projects**. Only less than 1 million € of programme funds remain uncommitted. The Programme Committee will make a decision on the use of these funds by 2013.


